

General terms and conditions for newsletter, invitation dispatch and event registration

The following general terms and conditions and data protection information apply to the invitations to events of the Institute for New Energy Systems of Ingolstadt University of Technology. Ingolstadt University of Applied Sciences, for newsletters as well as for the registration and participation in events of Ingolstadt University of Technology (hereinafter "THI").

1. Scope of application

1.1 These General Terms and Conditions (hereinafter "GTC") apply to newsletters (incl. event invitations) of the Institute for New Energy Systems of the Ingolstadt University of Technology. Ingolstadt. For this purpose, the THI offers the interested party the possibility to register for the subscription on a subpage of the THI website by means of a form provided there.

1.2 The interested party accepts the GTC by submitting the registration.

1.3 The interested party can call up, print and download these GTC by clicking on the link 'GTC'. or save them.

2. Consent, activation of the newsletter

2.1 All persons who are at least 16 years of age at the time of their registration are entitled to consent of their registration are at least 16 years old.

2.2 The registration process for the invitation mailing from THI is carried out via the so-called double opt-in procedure. After submitting the corresponding registration form, an automated e-mail is sent to the specified recipient address. In this e-mail the recipient is asked to confirm his or her inclusion in the database by clicking on a link. Only the entry in the distribution list is activated and the recipient will receive invitations to future events of the invitations to the events of the Institute for New Energy Systems.

2.3 By registering and clicking on the confirmation link, the interested party grants the express consent for the regular sending of event invitations.

3. Right of revocation

The consent to registration can be revoked at any time by clicking on the unsubscribe button at the end of the newsletter/invitation email (double opt-out procedure).

4. Liability

THI is not liable for incorrect information provided by subscribers and/or third parties, including the partners of THI, and which are connected with the sending of information about the information in connection with the sending of invitations. In particular, the THI does not assume any liability if e-mails or data entries (e.g. during registration procedures) registration procedures) do not comply with the technical requirements set out in these GTC or those set technical requirements set out in these GTC or for the website and are consequently not accepted and/or are accepted.

5. Final provisions

5.1 Any deviations from these GTC must be made in writing to be effective. The same shall apply with regard to the waiver of the written form requirement.

5.2 If individual provisions of these GTC are or become invalid and/or unenforceable, the remaining the validity of the remaining GTC shall remain unaffected.

5.3 The place of performance and jurisdiction for legal entities and merchants, insofar as an agreement to this effect is agreement is legally permissible, Ingolstadt.

Data protection information for registration and participation in events

1. Use of your data

1.1 Your data will be used on the basis of your consent within the meaning of Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. a DSGVO. Insofar as the subscriber does not give any additional consent for the further processing and use of his or her the registration process, including his personal data, these data will be used exclusively for the data provided by the subscriber in connection with the use of the registration, such data shall be stored by THI electronically in machine-readable form. THI stores the data only as long as you are registered. As soon as you no longer wish to receive invitations, your data will be deleted.

1.2 The data you provide when registering for an event will, unless you have THI will use the data you provide when registering for an event to process your registration for an event of the THI. Registration for an event of the THI. In a further In a further step, the THI uses your data to enable you to participate in the event. If necessary, your data will also be used to contact you, should it be necessary for us to send you further information about the event (e.g. changes to the (e.g. change of venue or time of the event). If the data is not provided, you will not receive event invitations. A registration to an event is also not possible in this case.

1.3 THI stores your first and last name in order to be able to address you personally. Be able to address you personally. We need your e-mail address in order to send you the event invitations. to be able to send you the event invitations. Your data will not be passed on to third parties. The data transfer and -processing takes place exclusively in Germany.

2. Data subject rights

According to the General Data Protection Regulation, you have the following rights:

5.1 If your personal data is processed, you have the right to obtain information about the data personal data stored about you (Art. 15 DSGVO).

5.2 If incorrect personal data is processed, you have the right to have it correction (Art. 16 DSGVO).

5.3 If the legal requirements are met, you may request the deletion or restriction of the processing as well as object to the processing (Art. 17, 18 and 21 DSGVO).

5.4 If you have consented to the data processing or if a contract for data processing and the data processing is carried out with the help of automated procedures, you have the right to You may have a right to data portability (Art. 20 DSGVO).

5.5 Should you make use of your above-mentioned rights, the public body will check whether the legal requirements for this are met.

5.6 Furthermore, there is a right of appeal.
