

English tests and certificates that are sufficient for admission to a degree programme for which level B2 (according to the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) is required:

- English Baccalaureate (Baccalaureate examination taken in English, with at least 4 points)
It is not relevant whether it is a subject-linked Abitur or a Allgemeine Hochschulreife (see GSO §61).
- English taken up to the Abitur; there must be at least 4 points in the Abitur certificate; if the Abitur was taken in Germany, proof of secondary level two is sufficient. In the case of foreign certificates, 8 school years of English should have been completed.
- Successful completion of an English-language Bachelor degree programme
- TOEFL ibt (internet-based) with a score of at least 71
- TOEFL ITP with a score of at least 543
- IELTS (International English Language Testing System)
- Cambridge FCE
- Cambridge ESOL Level 1 (= Level B2 according to CEFR)
- MOTET (Mondiale Online Technical English Test)
- MOTET (General Technical English Module)
- Unicert II
- LCCI (Business Certificate) - Level 3 (= B2 + C1) required
- Level subdivisions - e.g. **B 2.1./ B2.2.** - both are sufficient for admission
- PTE Academic (Level B2)

If you need Knowledge in English on Level B2 (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages) for starting a study course, you have to verify these English skills. Possible verifications are:

- TOEFL ibt (internet-based) minimum 71 points
- TOEFL ITP minimum 543 Points
- IELTS (International English Language Testing System)
- Cambridge FCE
- Cambridge ESOL Level 1 (= Level B2 CEFR)
- MOTET (Mondiale Online Technical English Test)
- MOTET (General Technical English Module)
- Unicert II
- LCCI (Business Certificate) - Level 3 (= B2 + C1) necessary
- First study course in English

There is no difference between Level B2.1 and B2.2.
